

GABRIELLE TEE'S STUDIO POLICY 2024-2025

As a music instructor, my ultimate goal is to provide a nurturing and supportive environment for students of all ages and skill levels. Learning an instrument is both rewarding and challenging, and I break down the learning process into manageable steps to give students a sense of accomplishment each week. I tailor lessons to a student's individual learning style and musical interests. I offer lessons in piano, guitar, ukulele, theory, music history, and songwriting.

STUDENT & FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES

Students agree to arrive at each lesson punctually, prepared to the best of their abilities, with their materials in hand. Students and parents agree to set aside time daily for practice. Practicing even 10 minutes a day is better than cramming for an hour before your lesson! If there are ever questions about assignments, please ask during lessons or email me during the week.

If something is happening at home or school that is affecting you or your child, please let me know. A quick text before lessons can make the difference between a great lesson and a difficult one.

If a student is repeatedly absent, late, and unprepared, I may ask the family to take a break from lessons and re-evaluate their commitment. Additionally, if a student decides to take a break from lessons, I ask that you provide one month's notice.

TUITION

Tuition covers 35 individual lesson slots per school year, two recitals, and the time preparing for each lesson. Tuition is due by the first lesson of the month. A \$10 late fee is applied to tuition received after the 10th of the month.

I accept cash, check, PayPal, and Venmo. Families paying in cash will receive a \$10/month discount. Tuition is a flat monthly rate, meaning I don't charge extra for months with 5 lessons, nor do I charge less over the holiday breaks.

Tuition Rates:

30 minute - \$150/month

45 minute - \$200/month

60 minute- \$250/month

MATERIALS

To further simplify billing, I charge for materials once a year. This annual \$55 fee will cover all performance repertoire, lesson books, theory workbooks, and games. Students are always welcome to make specific requests (Disney songs, Taylor Swift, etc) Paying this fee reserves your slot for the Fall semester (see those details below)

LOCATION

All lessons take place at my home studio in North Asheville. We live on a quiet street with plenty of street parking and no through-traffic.

Parents are also welcome to sit on the porch during the student's lesson time. If you choose to drop your child off, please be timely upon your return, as I will not be able to supervise the child past their individual lesson time. We do have one small, friendly cat. Students should be able to interact with animals in a kind manner.

SUMMER LESSONS

To stay enrolled and to reserve a slot for fall, students need to enroll in at least 3 lessons over the summer. I will send out an email in May with sign-up times, and slots are first-come, first-serve.

FALL LESSONS

Fall slots are first open to currently enrolled families. In May, you will receive a sign-up form to enroll. Priority is given to students who have enrolled in summer classes and have a high attendance rate across the year.

CANCELATION POLICY

While I understand that school activities, illnesses, and family events may fall on a student's lesson day, I am unable to offer your family more than one weekly slot. Please inform me of any absences, but know that I'm unable to give you another time during that week. Upon request, I am happy to email instructions or send a video lesson to keep the student continuing making progress!

If I am sick or unable to make a lesson for any reason, families will be reimbursed for your lesson time.

PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES

Every student is invited to perform in two recitals a year: Winter Recital in December, and Spring Recital in May. I encourage students to seek additional opportunities such as school talent shows, open mic nights, and student ensembles.
